TIME & PLACE

March starts at 3:00 p.m. at 12th & Locust St. (Arrive by 2:30 p.m.) We will march west on 12th St. to Grand Ave. and then north to Pershing Rd. Then proceed west to the north terrace of the WWI Museum and Memorial.

Rally will follow the march, ending at approximately 5:00 p.m. (No transport for marchers returning to 12th & Locust start location.)

MOTORCADE & SPECIAL NEEDS

Assembly/line-up for a motorcade is at 2:30 p.m. on 12th St.

Persons may register their vehicles to participate in the motorcade. (Motorcade will offer special access/drop-off at the north terrace of WWI M&M for the handicapped.)

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Water will be provided free of charge. Your own snacks and beverages will be allowed. No alcohol or drugs.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Masks and social distancing are required. Outdoor portal potties will be provided at WWI M&M. Conflict resolution experts will be present. Ambulatory services and first aid assistance will be available. Marked and unmarked security will be present. No weapons or firearms allowed.
